## NATIONAL EGG REVIEW



As the week began prices were higher on all sizes except in New York where prices were unchanged. As the week progressed New York prices were lower on mediums only. Trade sentiment was steady on the larger sizes and barely steady on the light weights. Demand was in a full range of light to moderate. Supplies of large were adequate while mediums were fully adequate to ample. Breaking stock prices were lower to unchanged while checks and undergrades were unchanged. Demand was fair to fairly good while most breakers didn't require additional breaking stock. Offerings of heavy weight breaking stock continued light with light weight product readily available. Floor stocks were in close balance to adequate. Schedules were full time. Trade sentiment was cautiously steady. Light type hen demand was fairly good with offerings slightly more available for next week. Schedules were full time. Trade sentiment was steady. Removal prices continue at 5 to 9 cents, mostly 5 cents per head.

**MIDWEST REGIONAL** Prices were unchanged. Trade sentiment was steady for the larger sizes and barely steady to weak for the lighter weight eggs. Cartoned egg sales were light to at times fairly good, usually light to moderate. Loose egg demand was slow to mostly moderate. Supplies were adequate for the larger sizes and fully adequate to available for medium and small. Central states breaking stock prices were unchanged. Demand was fair to fairly good with most breakers showing no concern in obtaining additional breaking stock. Offerings of heavy weight breaking stock continued light with light weight product readily available. Floor stocks in close balance to adequate. Schedules full-time. Trade sentiment cautiously steady.

**NORTHEAST REGIONAL** Prices were unchanged, however mediums were trending slightly lower. The market tone was barely steady on mediums, but the heavier weight eggs continued in a steady position. Demand slowed in some locations and ranged mostly light to moderate. Supplies were adequate for the larger sizes, but reported as fully adequate to instances available on mediums. Breaking stock offerings were about adequate for the moderate to good demand. Spent hens were fully sufficient for slaughter needs.

**WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING** Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 06-Nov-04 is estimated at 158.6 million head. This compares to 159.7 million head the previous week and to 154.5 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 160.0 million head and the composite weighted average price was 63.77 cents per pound.






### New York Large Weekly Average Price
