**MIDWEST** Preliminary majority prices for next week's deliveries into Chicago area were unchanged from Monday's final majority price. Whole broiler/fryer trade sentiment was steady. Trade interest was light on adequate offerings. Retail movement ranged light to instances good with best interest into featured items. Demand into food service sectors was light to fairly good with catering and fast food entities most active. Floor stocks were adequate with desirable to light weights. Supplies of dark meat items were barely adequate to tight with the balance of parts adequate. The trade sentiment on dark meat cuts was fully steady to firm and steady on the balance parts.
