**NATIONAL EGG REVIEW**

Prices were higher on all sizes in all areas throughout the week. The market tone was steady to fully steady. Demand was moderate to good. Supplies were sufficient to tight for large and generally adequate for all other sizes. Prices for breaking stock and checks and undergrades were higher. Offerings remained light for the light to usually moderate demand. Most breakers attempted to resist paying higher prices for breaking stock by reducing schedules this week but those forced to make purchase were paying the high side of the quoted range. Floor stocks were very tight. The trade sentiment was steady. Removal costs for spent hens were unchanged to slightly higher. Offerings were adequate to close for current delivery and deliveries planned for next week. Demand was moderate to instances good for the steady trade sentiment. Removal prices were .5-11 cents, mostly 6-9 cents per head.

**MIDWEST REGIONAL** Prices were unchanged. Trade sentiment was steady. Cartoned egg demand was moderate to at times good. Food service sales were moderate. Supplies were in balance to tight for large and usually adequate for the balance. Central states breaking stock prices were unchanged with checks and undergrades 1 cent higher. Offerings were remained light for the light to usually moderate demand. Schedules were reduced. Floor stocks were very tight. Trade sentiment was steady.

**NORTHEAST REGIONAL** Prices were unchanged, however asking prices for next week's deliveries were trending slightly higher on all sizes. Trade sentiment ranged steady to fully steady entering the holiday weekend. Retail and distributive demand was moderate to good. Supplies were generally adequate for full trade requirements. Breaking stock offerings were limited for normal to less than normal schedules. Demand was noted as moderate. Light type hens were mostly adequate to about adequate for the fair to fairly good demand. Processing schedules were reported as regular.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 17-Dec-05 is estimated at 154.2 million head. This compares to 154.8 million head the previous week and to 154.3 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 161.2 million head and the composite weighted average price was 68.00 cents per pound.






### New York Large Weekly Average Price
