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Egg production in Canada was up 5.9% to 586.8 million dozen in 2005 over the 2004 level of production at 554.2 million dozen. The annual increase was attributed to the repopulation of flocks as a result of an outbreak of avian influenza in British Columbia in 2004, which caused a depopulation of 75% to 80% of the provincial flock. At present, egg production in March of 2006 was 50.0 million dozen eggs, which is 2.9% higher than the same period a year ago (48.6 million dozen eggs). Ontario led Canada's provinces in egg production, producing 228.9 million dozen eggs in 2005 and 19.3 million dozen eggs in March of 2006. Behind Ontario in million dozens were Quebec (104.1), Manitoba (85.1), British Columbia (54.8), and Alberta (45.8).

In general, the production of Canadian egg products dropped between 2003 and 2004 with a turn around increase 2005. Canada processed 51.9 million kilograms (kg) of egg products in 2005, which was comprised of 27.0 million kg of whole egg, 8.7 million kg of yolk, and 16.1 million kg of albumen. (cont'd)



Frozen eggs processed in 2005 totaled 6.5 million kg with 2.7 million kg whole egg, 2.9 million kg yolk, and .9 million kg albumen. A total of 30.3 million kg liquid eggs were processed in Canada in 2005: 22.3 million kg whole egg, 3.1 million kg yolk, and 4.9 million kg albumen. Canada produced 1.0 million kg of dried whole egg, 1.2 million kg of dried yolk, and 1.7 million kg of dried albumen in 2005 reaching a total of 3.8 million kg of dried eggs processed for the year.

In regards to the production of poultry, Canada realized a decrease of 2.7 million birds between 2003 (635.8 million) and 2004 (633.0 million head), which was followed by an increase of 13.7 million birds to 646.7 million in 2005. Canada produced 611.1 million chickens in 2005 and 20.5 million turkeys, which comprised 94.5% and 3.2% of total poultry produced respectively. Ontario led Canada's provinces in both the production of chicken and turkey with 196.5 million and 8.5 million birds respectively. Following Ontario in both chicken and turkey production in million head were Quebec 158.4 chickens, 4.3 turkeys; British Columbia 101.5 chickens, 2.7 turkeys; Alberta 53.0 chickens, 1.8 turkeys; and Manitoba 28.9 chickens, 1.4 turkeys in 2005. According to 2006 projections made in late 2005, chicken production is expected to increase 1% to 2%, while turkey remains relatively unchanged.

Around 28.1 million US dollars of shell eggs were exported in 2005 by Canada with leading importers by million US dollar (USD) value being US (8.6), Germany (8.0), Austria (4.4), Turkey (3.3), and Poland (1.4). About 12.2 million USD of egg products were exported in 2005 with Japan leading with 3.4 million USD followed by Venezuela (2.6), US (2.4), Germany (0.6), and Taiwan (0.5). Canada exported 134.2 million USD of poultry with the top five importers by million USD value being U.S. (65.9), South Africa (13.4), Philippines (9.4), Russia (7.9), and Hong Kong (5.8).
