Trade sentiment was usually steady to about steady on most items. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending 26-Aug-2006 were 2 % less than the previous week, and 7 % lower than a year ago; the total todate of liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) was about 4% less than the total a year earlier.

Trading was light with offerings adequate to sufficient for trade needs. Trade sentiment was generally steady. Dried eggs processed under federal inspection for the week ending 26-Aug-2006 were 12 % less than the previous week, and 15 % less than a year ago. The total year to date production on dried eggs produced was a tad lower but the percentage was unchanged when compared to a year earlier.
