MIDWEST Preliminary majority prices on next week's deliveries into the Chicago area moved 5 cents higher from Monday's majority. Fill-in trade on mixed wogs was noted into Ohio market area at 74 cents. The market tone on whole broiler/fryers was fully steady to firm. Offerings were very light. Retail and food service demand was light to moderate, occasionally good into fast food. Floor stocks were in balance; weights desirable. Parts offerings were limited. Trading was hand to mouth and selective. Supplies of all parts were in balance, tightest for tenderloins and dark meat cuts. The market tone was fully steady to firm on leg items, steady to fully steady on breast cuts and steady on wings.
