



NATIONAL EGG REVIEW



At the beginning of the week prices were lower on all sizes in all areas except New York where prices were unchanged. As the week progressed prices were unchanged in all locations. Trade sentiment was steady to instances firm. Demand was light to good, best where winter storms were present. Supplies were adequate to fully adequate and confidently held. Central States breaking stock and checks and undergrade prices were unchanged. Offerings were tight and with a light to moderate demand. Floor stocks were adequate. Schedules were full-time. Trade sentiment was steady with a firm undertone. Spent hen removal costs were unchanged to slightly higher. Demand was light to moderate with adequate offerings. Schedules were normal for next week. Trade was sentiment steady. Removal costs were 5 to 9 cents per head.

PRICES TO RETAILERS, SALES TO VOLUME BUYERS, USDA GRADE A AND GRADE A, WHITE EGGS IN CARTONS, DELIVERED WAREHOUSE, CENTS PER DOZEN.

MIDWEST REGIONAL Prices were unchanged. Trade sentiment steady was fully steady to instances firm. Cartoned and loose egg sales were moderate to fairly good as delivery schedules returned to normal following the snow storm earlier in the week. Supplies were fully adequate to at times ample and continued to be held with confidence. Central States breaking stock prices were unchanged. Demand was light to mostly moderate. Offerings were tight to barely adequate. Floor stocks were balanced to adequate. Schedules were full-time. Trade sentiment steady with a firm undertone.

NORTHEAST REGIONAL Prices were unchanged on all sizes. Trade sentiment was steady with traders closey watching further market developments. Demand was light to good, with retail movement being affected by inclimate weather. Supplies were adequate to fully adequate for trade requirements. Breaking stock demand was fair to good for irregular but sufficient offerings. Light type hen offerings were generally adequate for normal processing schedules.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 24-Mar-07 is estimated at 157.6 million head. This compares to 158.2 million head the previous week and to 164.9 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 164.1 million head and the composite weighted average price was 60.89 cents per pound.






New York Large Weekly Average Price cents per dozen
