**MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER** - Final majority prices into major markets moved higher over last Monday's final; Ohio cities TFEWR. Whole broiler/fryer market tone was steady to firm. Offerings limited, but adequate for light trade call. Retail movement was slow to moderate. Food service was mixed, slow to good, mostly moderate and best into fast food. Floor stocks were in balance to long; weights mixed. Parts trade call was light and on as needed basis. Supplies of large wings plentiful, regular sized wings and remaining items were in close balance. The market tone was barely steady to weak on large wings; all other parts were generally steady to occasionally firm.
