**WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING**

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 14-Jul-07 is estimated at 166.3 million head. This compares to 165.4 million head the previous week and to 163.7 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 162.4 million head and the composite weighted average price was 67.50 cents per pound.






**New York Large Weekly Average Price**
