



USDA EGG MARKET NEWS REPORT

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NATIONAL EGG MARKET AT-A-GLANCE

In New York, prices were unchanged on all weights when compared to Friday's values. Elsewhere, regional prices were higher on all weights. Trade sentiment was firm. Demand was moderate to good. Supplies were adequate to short for trade needs. Breaking stock offerings were short to about sufficient for a moderate to good demand. Light type hens were mostly adequate for the fair to at least moderate demand.

MIDWEST REGIONAL Midwest delivered prices were sharply higher for all sizes. Prices to producers in IA-MN-WI were unchanged. Trade sentiment was firm. Cartoned egg demand was moderate to usually good. Loose egg movement was moderate to fairly good. Supplies were closely balanced to barely adequate. Central states breaking stock prices were unchanged. Demand was fairly good to good. Offerings were very tight to generally inadequate. Schedules full-time. Trade sentiment mostly firm.

Light type hen offerings were sufficient for a fair demand.

The Pacific inventory was 1% higher than last Monday, with California increasing 14% and OR-WA-UT down 18%. Trade sentiment was fully steady to firm. Offerings were adequate to about adequate with demand fair to instances good.

CALIFORNIA Benchmark prices increased 14 cents on jumbo, extra large, and large, with medium 5 cents higher. The Pacific inventory increased 1% from last Monday, with California up 14% and OR-WA-UT down 18%. Trade sentiment was fully steady to firm. Retailer demand was fair to fairly good with offerings adequate to about adequate in most locations. Small benchmark price 74 cents.
