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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

New York egg prices began the week unchanged with prices sharply higher for all sizes as the week progressed. Elsewhere, prices were higher on all sizes. Demand was light to good, usually moderate to good. Supplies were sufficient to tight. Central states breaking stock prices were higher. Offerings were tight to unavailable with demand fairly good to good. Schedules were full-time. The trade sentiment was fully steady to firm. Spent hen removal costs were unchanged. Demand was light to fairly good with adequate offerings. Trade sentiment was steady. Spent hen removal prices continued to be mostly unchanged.

PRICES TO RETAILERS, SALES TO VOLUME BUYERS, USDA GRADE A AND GRADE A, WHITE EGGS IN CARTONS, DELIVERED WAREHOUSE, CENTS PER DOZEN.

MIDWEST REGIONAL Prices to producers in IA-MN-WI were higher for large and medium and unchanged on small. Other reported prices were unchanged. Trade sentiment continues firm. Cartoned egg demand ranged from light to good but was usually moderate. Loose egg movement was moderate to very good. Supplies were closely balanced to tight. Central states breaking stock prices were higher. Demand was mostly good. Offerings were tight to unavailable. Schedules full-time. Trade sentiment was fully steady to firm.

NORTHEAST REGIONAL Prices were unchanged, however mediums and heavier weight eggs were trending significantly higher. The market tone was firm. Demand was moderate to instances good. Supplies were usually adequate to tight for current trade needs. Eastern region breaking stock offerings were short to barely adequate for a moderate to good demand. Light hen offerings were sufficient for the fair to at least moderate demand.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 04-Aug-07 is estimated at 166.3 million head. This compares to 166.4 million head the previous week and to 163.8 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 164.1 million head and the composite weighted average price was 67.40 cents per pound.




