NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

All regional prices were unchanged at the beginning of the week. During the week, New York egg prices were lower. Retail and distributive demand was light to moderate. Supplies were adequate with the heavier weights in the longest position. Breaking stock prices were unchanged early week and were lower during the week. Offerings were adequate, however increased throughout the week. The volume of graded loose shell eggs offered was increasing by the end of the week. In the north central region spent hen removal costs remained unchanged. Demand was light with offerings tight to adequate. The trade sentiment was steady. North central spent hen removal prices continued to be 0-9 cents, mostly 4 to 8 cents per head.

PRICES TO RETAILERS, SALES TO VOLUME BUYERS, USDA GRADE A AND GRADE A, WHITE EGGS IN CARTONS, DELIVERED WAREHOUSE, CENTS PER DOZEN.

MIDWEST REGIONAL Prices were sharply lower for producer price on large and mediums, other prices were unchanged. Trade sentiment was weak. Cartoned egg demand was light to moderate at best. Distributive movement was mostly light. Supplies were fully adequate to ample with the larger sizes in the longest position. Central states breaking stock prices were unchanged. Offerings were adequate to fully adequate and demand was moderate to good. Offerings of graded loose large eggs expanding in volume. Floor stocks were adequate to fully adequate. Schedules full-time. Trade sentiment mostly steady.

NORTHEAST REGIONAL Prices were unchanged. However, values continue to trend lower. Trade sentiment was weak and unsettled. Retail demand was slow and disappointing. Supplies were fully adequate to ample for present trade requirements with larger weights in the longest position. Breaking stock offerings in the Eastern region were reported as adequate to increasing in availability for a moderately active demand. Light type hens were adequate for normal to instances heavy processing schedules.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 08-Sep-07 is estimated at 162.4 million head. This compares to 163.4 million head the previous week and to 162.0 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 156.5 million head and the composite weighted average price was 69.32 cents per pound.




