NATIONAL EGG MARKET AT-A-GLANCE



In New York, prices were unchanged on all sizes when compared to Thursday's values. The market tone was weak entering the weekend. Demand ranged very light to moderate. Supplies were adequate to ample with the heavier weights in the longest position. Breaking stock offerings were sufficient to fully adequate for the light to fairly good demand. Light type fowl supplies were generally adequate for the fair demand. Processing schedules were noted as normal to occasionally heavy.

MIDWEST REGIONAL Prices for warehouse and store delivery were unchanged. Iowa-Minnesota-Wisconsin producer prices 5 cents lower on large and mediums. Trade sentiment was weak. Cartoned egg demand was irregular, light to occasionally fairly good. Food service movement was mostly fair. Supplies were adequate to ample with the larger sizes in the longest position. Central states breaking stock prices were lower. Offerings were adequate to fully adequate for the light to fairly good demand. Floor stocks were adequate to fully adequate and building as graded loose eggs move to breaking channels. Schedules full-time. Trade sentiment cautiously steady to barely steady.

Breaking stock offerings in the Eastern region were reported as adequate to increasing in availability for normal to instances heavy schedules. Light type hens offerings were mostly adequate for a no better than fair demand.

EASTERN REGION BREAKING STOCK Prices were lower when compared to early week trading. Trade sentiment was barely steady to mostly weak with traders continuing to watch further market developments. Offerings were adequate to fully sufficient and increasing in availability. Breaking schedules were normal to occasionally heavy. Demand and inquiry slowed but was still moderately active. Total cases broken under federal inspection from January through the week ending 28-Jul-2007 were 3% less than a year earlier. In the Eastern region, total cases broken during the week of 28-Jul-2007 were 1% more than the previous week, but 5% less than last year.

CENTRAL REGION FROZEN Frozen whole egg ranged unchanged to 1 cent lower with whites unchanged to 3 cents higher. Sugared yolk ranged 1 to 4 cents higher with salted yolk 2 to 4 cents higher. Trade sentiment was steady to fully steady for whole egg and whites with yolk products remaining in a firm position. Demand was moderate to fairly good for all frozen products with offerings balanced to adequate. Breaking stock prices were slightly lower when compared to the previous week's reported prices.

Supplies were reported as short to barely adequate for trade needs. The undertone was at least steady to fully steady. Dried eggs processed under federal inspection for the week ending 28-Jul-2007 were 2% more than the previous week, and unchanged from a year ago. The total production year to date of dried eggs processed was 16% less than a year earlier.
