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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

All regional prices were sharply lower at the beginning of the week except for New York, which was unchanged. During the week, New York egg prices were slightly lower and all other reported prices were unchanged. The trade sentiment was steady to at times weak. Retail and distributive demand was light to mostly moderate with the best movement coming from areas with retail feature activity. Supplies were adequate to fully adequate. Breaking stock prices were slightly lower earlier in the week and unchanged during most of the week. Offerings were adequate for the fair to good demand. Floor stocks were adequate to fully adequate. Schedules were full-time. The trade sentiment was steady. The north central region spent hen removal costs remained unchanged. Demand was light with offerings light to adequate. The trade sentiment was steady. North central spent hen removal prices continued to be 0-9 cents, mostly 4 to 8 cents per head.

MIDWEST REGIONAL Prices to producers in IA-MN-WI were 2 cents lower for large. Other reported prices were unchanged. Trade sentiment was steady to at times weak. Retail demand was light to mostly moderate, best into areas with retail feature activity. Food service movement was mostly moderate. Supplies were adequate to fully adequate. Central states breaking stock prices were unchanged. Offerings were adequate for the fair to good demand. Floor stocks adequate to fully adequate. Schedules full-time. Trade sentiment steady.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 15-Sep-07 is estimated at 164.9 million head. This compares to 162.4 million head the previous week and to 163.7 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 168.5 million head and the composite weighted average price was 69.86 cents per pound.






New York Large Weekly Average Price
