



Frozen Turkey Cuts, and Frozen Fowl Cuts**




**Price Comparison of Fresh Boneless Pork Picnics,

Russia

The Food Safety Inspection Service (FSIS) announced on October 18, 2007 the ineligibility of an additional 14 poultry establishments from being approved for export to Russia effective November 1, 2007. The poultry establishments became ineligible to export to Russia as a result of reviews conducted during July, 2007. The 14 poultry establishments delisted include the 7 delisted in July and 2 in May.

Poultry establishments ineligible as of November 1, 2007, as indicated on FSIS's List of Approved Raw Poultry and Cold Storage Establishments can be approved for export to Russia upon FSIS verification of correction of deficiencies identified by Russian officials during the July 2007 reviews.

Plant management must submit a corrective action plan to the FSIS IIC that lists each deficiency identified on the review form (Act of Inspection) completed by the Russian official at the time of the review and that lists each corrective action taken by the plant. The IIC should verify that the corrective actions are adequate.

Once the corrective actions are verified as adequate, the IIC should complete an FSIS letterhead verification document and fax the verification document and the corrective action plan from plant management to the Import/Export Programs Staff. After review of the documents, FSIS, Office of International Affairs will notify Russian officials of the corrective actions. Following the notification, the plant list will be revised to indicate eligibility of the establishment.

The market tone on white meat continued steady to weak with breast trim steadiest. Demand light to instances moderate. Offerings of breast trim light, balance of white meat adequate to ample. The market tone on 4-8 lb. breasts was steady to fully steady, institutional sized breasts mostly steady. Demand light to moderate. Offerings of 4-8 lb. breasts light, institutional sized breasts light to adequate with some buyers noting institutional sized breasts not as tight as previous weeks. Some cautiousness is being noted by a few buyers on 2008 contracts as they ponder future needs and prices in relation to competing meats. Trading slow to moderate. For domestic: tails 28, fresh breast trim 136-139, Grade non-basted rib breasts - 8-10 lb. 145 and 12-16 lb. 190 cents delivered. For export: defatted gizzards - hen 70.50, tom 91-92, Russian frozen thigh meat 105 cents delivered.
