



NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Prices in all regions slightly higher from the period before. Prices in New York increased sharply during the period. The trade sentiment was fully steady to generally firm on all sizes. Demand into all outlets was moderate to good. Supplies were in balance to tight in the Midwest and South Central regions. Breaking stock prices increased throughout the period. Offerings were tight to short of needs. Demand remained good although some breakers had stopped bidding for additional breaking stock due to price concerns. Breaking schedules full-time to reduced. The trade sentiment was firm. In the north central region spent hen prices were slightly higher. Demand was moderate to fairly good. Offers were adequate. The trade sentiment was steady.

MIDWEST REGIONAL Prices to producers in IA-MN-WI were higher for all sizes. Other reported prices were unchanged. The trade sentiment was firm. Retail demand was moderate to very good. Food service movement was mostly moderate. Supplies were balanced to tight and held with confidence. Central states breaking stock prices were higher. Offerings were very tight to short of needs. Demand good but a few breakers getting out of the bidding process due to higher prices. Floor stocks were balanced to tight. Schedules were full-time to reduced. Trade sentiment firm.

NORTHEAST REGIONAL Prices were unchanged. However, anticipated values are trending sharply higher for next week. Trade sentiment was mostly firm for the seasonal markets. Retail demand was light to mostly moderate. Supplies were adequate, but held with increased confidence. Breaking stock offerings in the Eastern region were light for a moderate to good demand. Light type hens were generally adequate for a moderate demand.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 08-Dec-07 is estimated at 158.8 million head. This compares to 158.4 million head the previous week and to 156.6 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 165.3 million head and the composite weighted average price was 65.83 cents per pound.

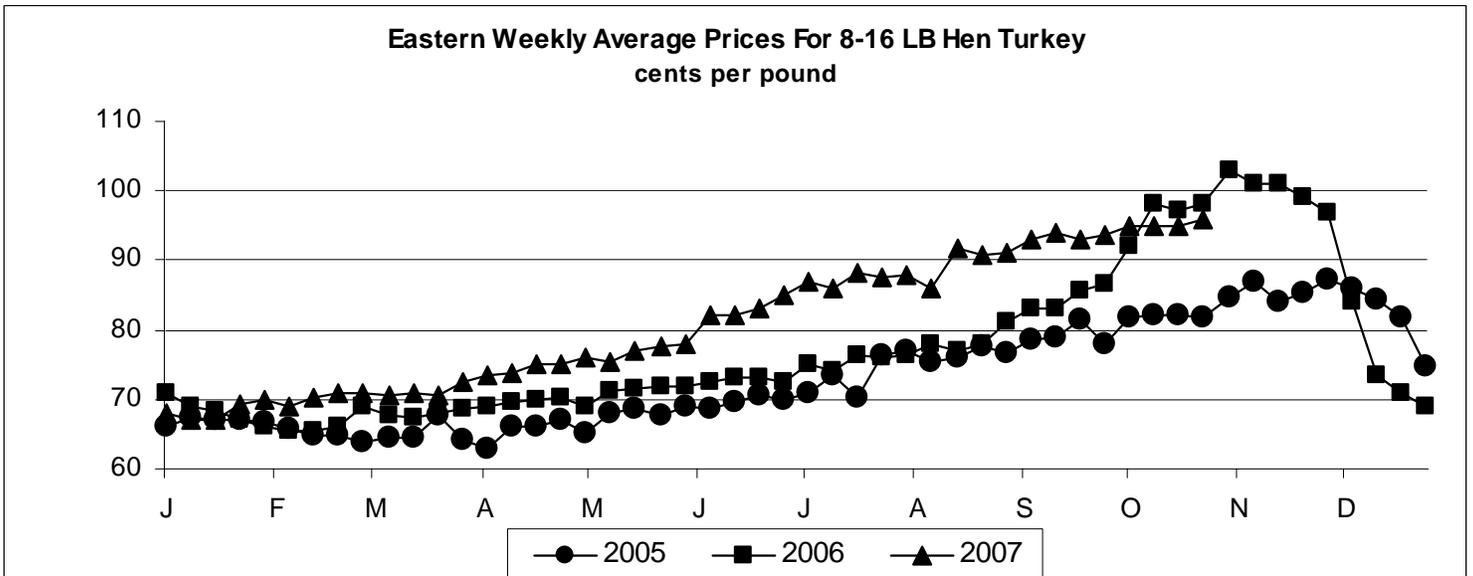
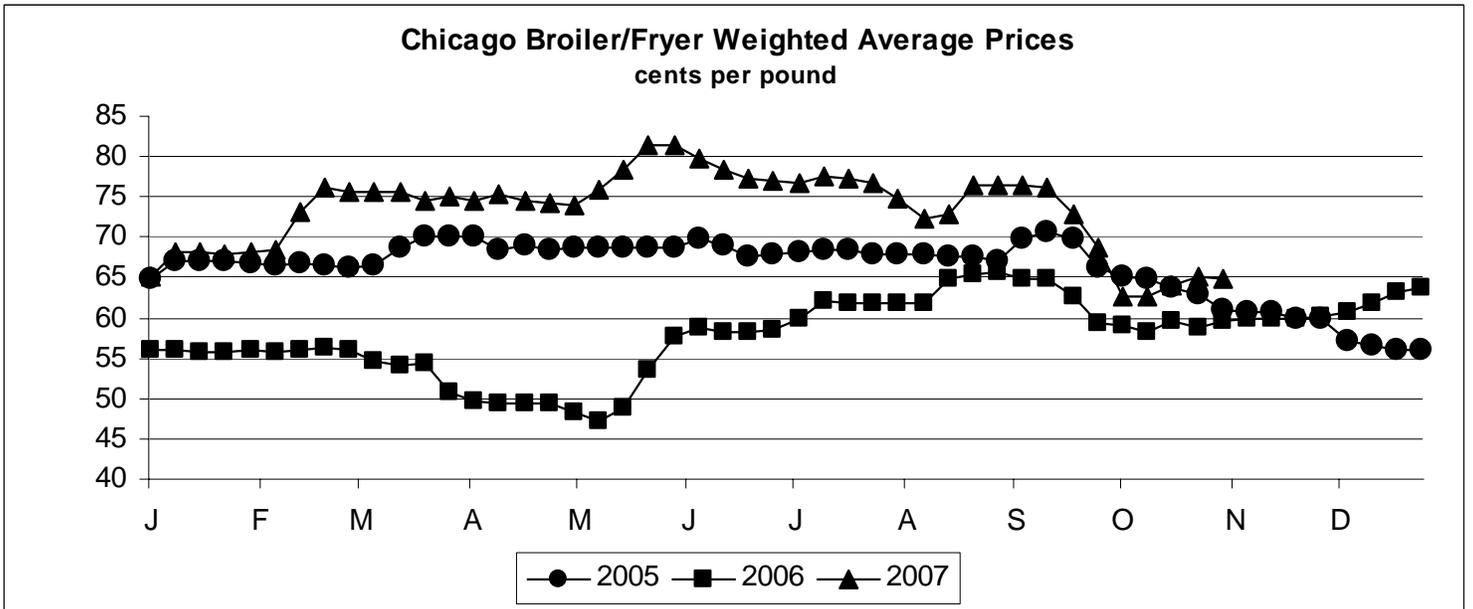
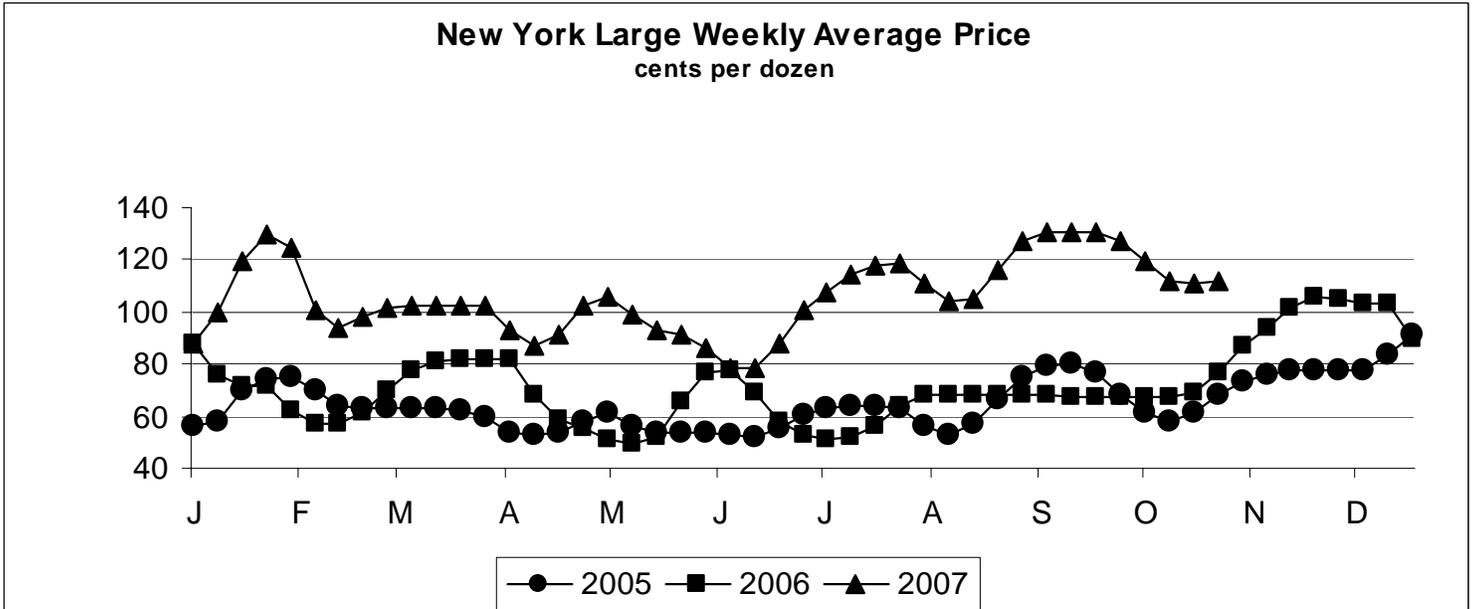
