**MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER** - Final majority prices into major markets were generally unchanged; Ohio cities TFEWR. Whole broiler/fryer market tone was steady on a cautious undertone. Producer offerings light on like trade call. Retail and food service movement was slow to moderate, best into fast food promotions and eight piece cut-up. Floor stocks adequate to fully adequate; some cutbacks noted to correct imbalance; weights mostly desirable. Parts trade on an as needed basis as turkey and other holiday items increase extra trade focus. Parts supplies were fully sufficient on light trade call. The market tone was generally steady on parts.
