**MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER** - Final majority prices increased 4 cents into Chicago, 3 cents into St. Louis, and 2 cents into Detroit; TFEWR into Ohio cities. Whole broiler/fryer market tone was steady to firm on limited offerings. Retail and distributive demand was light to moderate. Best movement on breasts, wings, and features. Floor stocks were balanced to short with weights desirable to heavy. Supplies of boneless dark meat were tight, close to barely adequate on breast cuts and wings, and barely adequate to adequate on the balance. The trade sentiment was steady to firm on all parts.
