### **NATIONAL BROILER MARKET AT-A-GLANCE**



Majority prices were higher in all areas when compared to previous week's prices. Trade sentiment was fully steady to firm. Retail demand was light to moderate, but sluggish in parts of the Midwest affected by winter weather which reduced buying activity and product flow. Food service was light to fairly good, best into fast food channels. Supplies of all sizes were in balance to tight and frequently moving at premium levels. Floor stocks were adequate to close. In the parts structure, trading was at least moderate to good following the weekend. Breast items and wings were in balance to tight, and dark meat was adequate with thighs and boneless cuts well cleared. In production areas, live supplies were moderate at mixed weights.

NORTHEAST REGION BROILER/FRYER Trucklot buying activity on ready-to-cook whole broiler/fryers was at least moderate to instances good as dealers assess market developments entering the week. Offerings of most sizes were clearing well with some premiums noted. Movement through retail and distributive channels was moderate. The market tone was fully steady to firm. In the parts complex, breast items, tenders and wings were in close balance to well cleared. Dark meat cuts were generally sufficient for current needs.

<u>SOUTHERN BROILER/FRYERS</u> Trade sentiment was fully steady to firm. Retail and food service demand was fair to moderate, best for features and fast food promotions. Supplies of all sizes were well balanced to short and moving well. In the parts structure, movement was moderate to good following the weekend. Breast items were barely adequate to tight and frequently clearing at premium levels. Wings were close balanced to short and moving satisfactorily. Dark meat was sufficient, but boneless cuts were in the closest balance.

WESTERN REGION BROILER/FRYERS Final majority prices were 1 cent higher throughout the region. The market tone was firm. Trading reported on truck lot deliveries for this week at higher to sharply higher prices. WOGs were in the strongest position. Offerings began the week in fair to adequate balance. Buying activity, although mixed, was overall moderate. Retailer demand was fairly good. Dealers reported moderate weekend carryovers. The market tone on parts remained steady to firm. The Los Angeles negotiated WOG average was at 81.00 up 9.65 with the volume reported at 32 loads up 3 percent.

MIDWEST REGION BROILER/FRYERS Final majority prices in all markets increased; Ohio cities TFEWR. Whole broiler/fryer market tone was fully steady to firm on very limited offerings. Retail demand was slowing; inclement winter weather affected product flow and consumer traffic. Food service demand was light to fairly good, best into fast food. Floor stocks were short to fully adequate; weights desirable to mixed. Supplies of leg quarters adequate, all other parts were in close balance. The market tone was steady to firm on wings and breast cuts, boneless dark meat, and thighs; other dark cuts were steady.

<u>DELMARVA BROILER/FRYERS</u> Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was moderate to good entering the week. Seller offerings were in good balance to tight for full trade needs. Live supplies were moderate; weights were mixed, but reported as mostly desirable. Processing schedules were moderate. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged to 1 cent higher at 77 to 88 cents. Trade sentiment ranged fully steady to firm. In the parts complex, breast items and wings were in close balance to short. Dark meat cuts were generally sufficient.

NORTHEAST BROILER/FRYER PARTS Trucklot buying interest remained at least moderate to good as most dealers noted excellent clearances over the weekend. Offerings of bone-in breast, wings and tenders were in close balance to tight; boneless skinless breast were good balance and clearing satisfactorily. Dark meat cuts were about adequate to adequate with thighs and thigh meat well cleared. Movement through retail and distributive channels was moderate. The market tone was fully steady to firm for breast items, wings and tenders; at least steady to fully steady for the balance of items.


### **National Mechanically Separated Chicken**

The MSC trade sentiment was fully steady to firm with prices noted as slightly higher. Supplies were about adequate to barely adequate on fresh 15-20% and close balance on the remainder for current needs; best call on Frozen 15-20%. Raw materials remained tight due to a variety of reasons ranging from higher rendering prices to slightly lighter weight birds. Domestic movement was moderate. Export demand was fairly good with good inquiry from Mexico and Central and South American countries. Schedules were mostly normal.
