New York and regional prices ended the week unchanged on all sizes. Trade sentiment was overall steady entering the holiday weekend. Retail and distributive demand was light to instances fairly good, mostly light to moderate. Supplies were in balance to fully adequate for trade requirements. Breaking stock offerings were barely adequate to tight for a light to fair demand. Light type hens were adequate for full time processing schedules.

Floor stocks in close balance. Schedules full-time. Trade sentiment was mostly steady to instances fully steady.

NATIONAL LIQUID Pasteurized whites were too few to report with pasteurized salt yolk ranging 1.28 to 1.30 fob. Trade sentiment was firm for whole egg, fully steady to firm for whites, and steady for yolk. Demand was good for whole egg, fairly good for whites, and fair for yolk. Offerings were short of needs for whole egg, tight to adequate for whites, and adequate for yolk. Breaking stock prices were higher when compared to the previous week's reported prices.

NATIONAL DRIED EGG REPORT Mostly prices were significantly higher on albumen, unchanged on yolks, irregular on whole when compared to a week earlier. Offerings were barely adequate to tight for a fair to good demand. Replacement costs on albumen was still reported higher than current price levels. Trade sentiment was firm on albumen, at least steady on whole and yolks. Dried eggs processed under federal inspection for the week ending 09-Feb-2008 were 10% less than the previous week and 18% less than a year ago. The total year to date production of dried eggs produced was 10% more than a year earlier.
