**MIDWEST REGION BROILER/FRYERS** - Final majority prices were unchanged to instances higher; Ohio cities TFEWR. Whole broiler/fryer market tone was steady. Retail and food service demand was in a full range, overall light to moderate. A major snow storm over the weekend in the Ohio valley delayed deliveries and hurt business as many shut down over weekend. Floor stocks were in close balance to ample; weights desirable to heavy. Parts trade was light; offerings were limited on dark meat cuts and small wings, other items fully adequate. The market tone was steady to fully steady on small wings and leg items; large wings and breast items steady to weak.
