



NATIONAL EGG REVIEW



In New York, prices increased on the larger sizes but were unchanged on mediums this period. All other reported regional prices were up sharply higher on the heavier weight eggs and ranged unchanged to higher on mediums. The trade sentiment was reported as steady to fully steady in all areas.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 26-Jul-08 is estimated at 165.1 million head. This compares to 163.9 million head the previous week and to 170.3 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 166.4 million head and the composite weighted average price was 80.51 cents per pound.

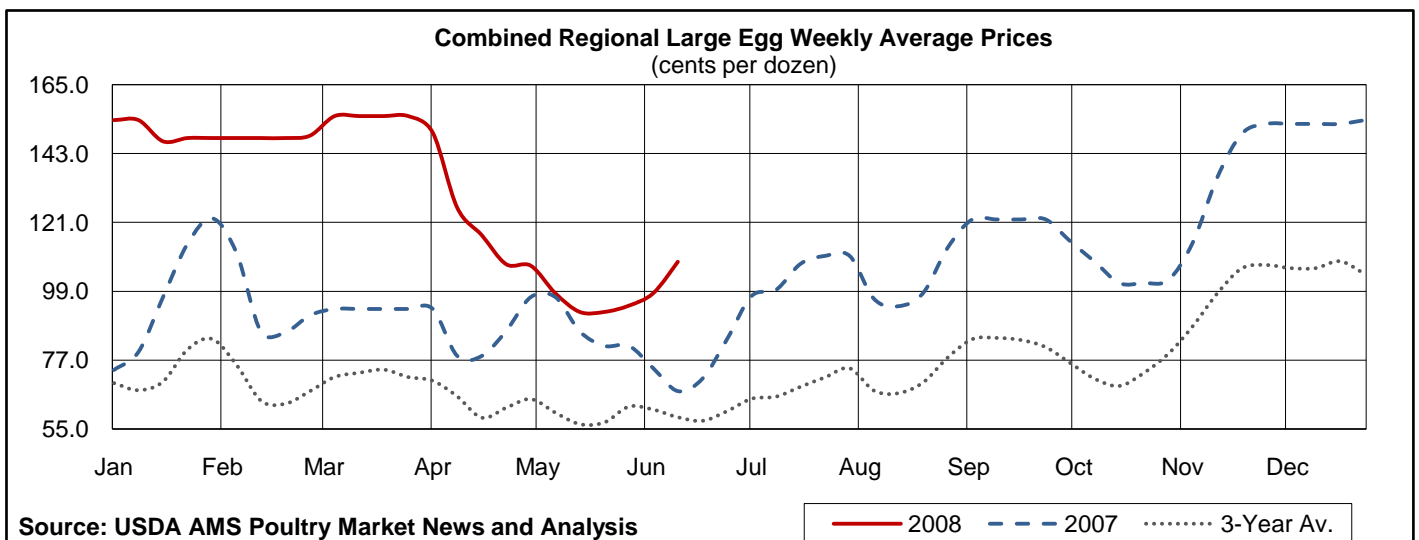
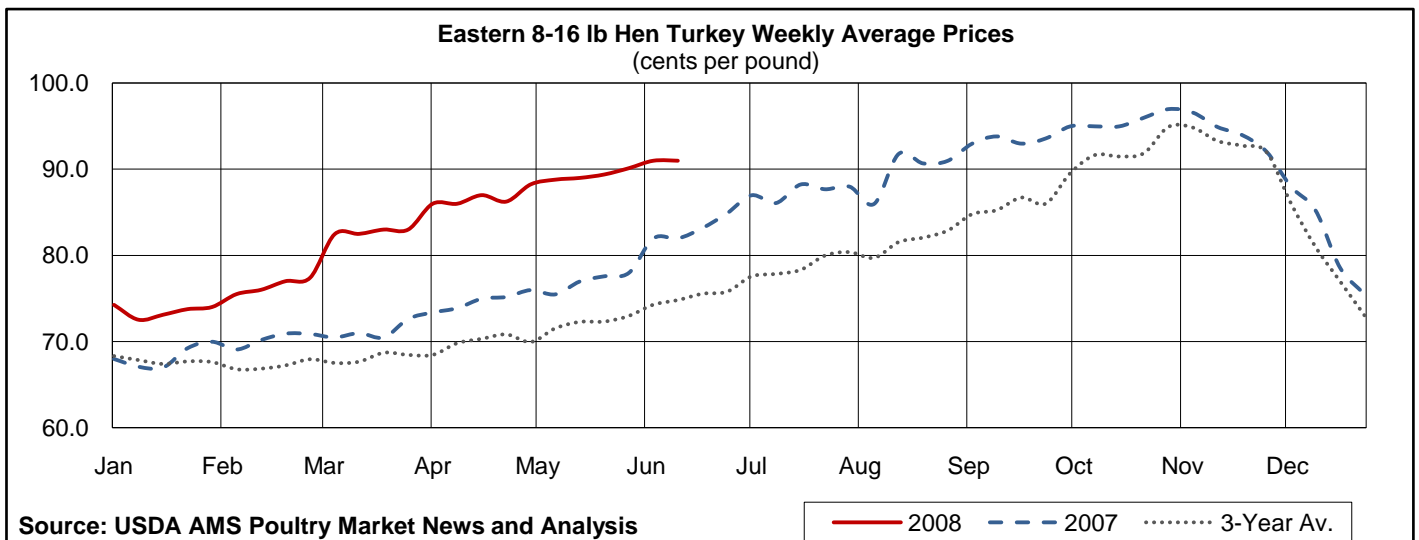
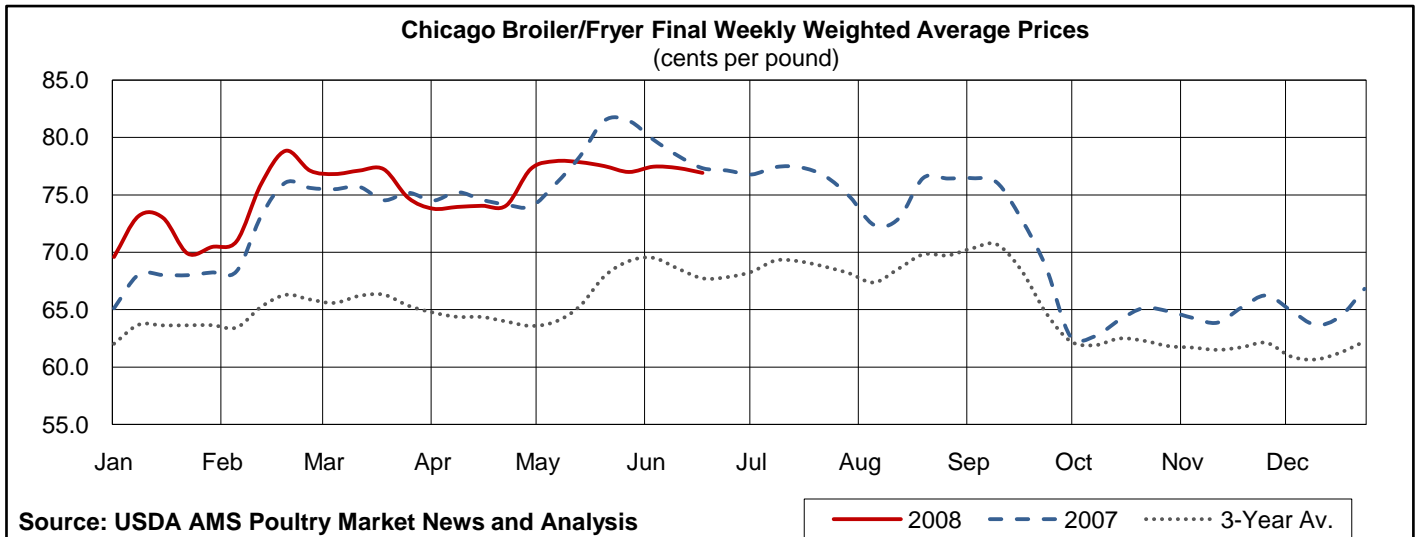
