MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER - Final majority delivered prices into Detroit were unchanged, St. Louis and Chicago were lower; Ohio cities TFEWR. Whole fryer market tone was steady to weak. Producer offerings were fully available on a very light trade call. Retail and food service demand slow to moderate; instances good into a few fast food and catering operations. Floor stocks were in a full range; weights desirable to mixed. Offerings of dark meat cuts were light, all other parts moderate to heavy. Trade sentiment on leg items and small wings was steady to firm, large wings steady to barely steady and steady to weak on balance of items.
