**MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER** - Final majority delivered prices into Midwest markets were generally unchanged; Ohio cities TFEWR. The market tone on whole broiler/fryers was steady. Offerings were light to moderate. Retail and food service demand was in a full range. Inclement weekend weather accompanied by strong winds and rain, caused flooding, electric service outages, and disrupted deliveries in several markets areas. Floor stocks were well cleared to ample; weights desirable to heavy. Trade on parts centered on wings and boneless/skinless breast. Part offerings were limited to adequate on light fill-in. The market tone was steady to firm on wings and steady on the balance.
