**MIDWEST REGION BROILER/FRYERS** - Final majority prices were generally 2 to 3 cents lower into Midwest markets; Ohio cities TFEWR. Whole broiler/fryer market tone was barely steady to weak; offerings available for the light needs. Retail and food service demand was light to instances fairly good with some noting better movement than anticipated over the weekend; best call on wings and eight piece cut-ups. Floor stocks were closely balanced to long; weights desirable to heavy. Supplies were adequate to available on dark meat cuts and breast items and tight on wings. The market tone was fully steady to firm on wings, steady on breast cuts, and steady to weak on dark meat items.
