MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER - Final majority prices moved lower into Midwest markets; Ohio cities TFEWR. Whole broiler/fryer market tone was steady to weak. Offerings were fully adequate for trade call. Retail and food service demand was light to instances fairly good. Floor stocks were closely balanced to long; weights desirable to heavy. Parts trade was best for wings, which were tight to short; other parts were available and clearance was spotty. The market tone was fully steady to firm on wings, barely steady to steady on breast cuts, and steady to weak on dark meat items.
