DOMESTIC MARKET HIGHLIGHTS



The market tone on 8-16 lb. hens and 16-24 lb. toms was steady to fully steady. Light to moderate trading was reported for prompt and deferred shipments. Demand was mixed with most interest noted for out front deliveries. Offerings were light to adequate. The market tone on bulk parts was steady with tom drums and tom necks steady to firm. Trading was slow to moderate. Demand was light except for tom drums, tom necks and tom two joint it was good. The market tone on White meat items was steady to weak. Trading and demand was slow. Offerings were fully adequate.

EXPORT MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

Trading centered on tom drums and thigh meat, balance of items was slow. Demand was light to moderate. Offerings were light to adequate.

The market tone on bulk parts was steady, with tom drums and tom necks fully steady to firm. Trading and demand was light to moderate with tom necks and tom drums good. Offerings were short to moderate. Trading and demand on white meat items remains inactive. Offerings were fully adequate. Domestic: fresh tom necks 51 cents, fresh full-cut wings 50 cents, mixed hens and toms full-cut wings 42 cents and mixed hens and toms tails 34 cent.
