



NATIONAL EGG REVIEW



Prices in New York increased on extra large and large, unchanged on mediums. Most regional prices increased slightly on the larger sizes. Next week's asking prices were trending higher on the heavier weights and unchanged for the lighter weights. The trade sentiment was fully steady to firm on the larger sizes and steady on medium. Retail demand ranged moderate to good. Food service demand was light to moderate. Supplies were closely balanced to adequate for the larger sized eggs and held with increased confidence. Medium supplies were adequate to instances available. Breaking stock prices, along with checks and undergrades, were higher. Offerings were tight to adequate for the moderate to good demand. Processing schedules were full-time. The trade sentiment was mostly steady with a firm undertone. North Central regional light hen removal costs were unchanged. Offerings were adequate for the light to moderate demand. Processing schedules were normal with heavy amounts of rendering. The trade sentiment remained steady.

PRICES TO RETAILERS, SALES TO VOLUME BUYERS, USDA GRADE A AND GRADE A, WHITE EGGS IN CARTONS, PRICES DELIVERED TO WAREHOUSE, CENTS PER DOZEN.

MIDWEST REGIONAL Producer prices were higher for large. Other reported prices were unchanged. The trade sentiment was fully steady to firm for the larger sizes and steady for the lighter weight eggs. Cartoned egg demand was moderate to good. Loose egg movement was usually light to moderate. Supplies of the larger sizes were adequate to closely balanced and were held with confidence while light weight egg supplies were adequate and building in some locations. Central states breaking stock prices were higher. Offerings were adequate to tight for the moderate to instances good demand. Schedules full-time. Trade sentiment was mostly steady, undertone firm.

NORTHEAST REGIONAL Prices were unchanged. Extra large and large egg prices were trending higher. Trade sentiment was fully steady to mostly firm on larger sizes, steady on mediums. Retail demand improved and ranged moderate to at times good. Supplies were about adequate to adequate for needs and continued to be held with confidence. Eastern region breaking stock offerings were short to sufficient for a moderate demand. Light type hen offerings were adequate for normal processing schedules.

**WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING**

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 25-Apr-09 is estimated at 155.1 million head. This compares to 153.9 million head the previous week and to 169.5 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 167.2 million head and the composite weighted average price was 78.90 cents per pound.

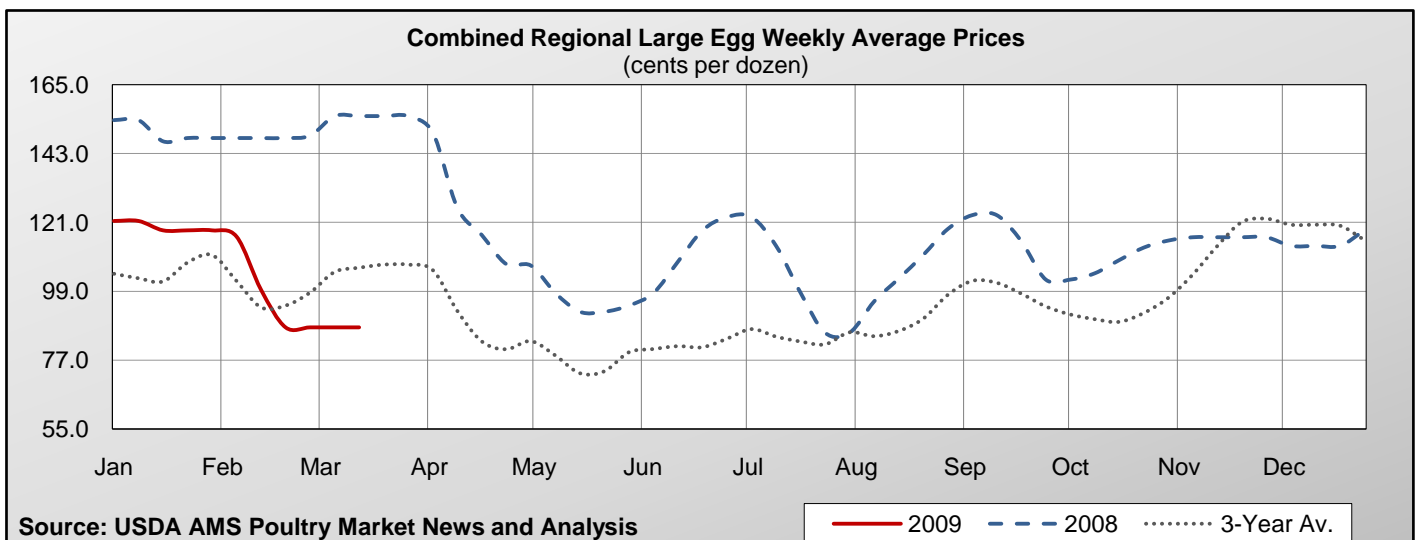
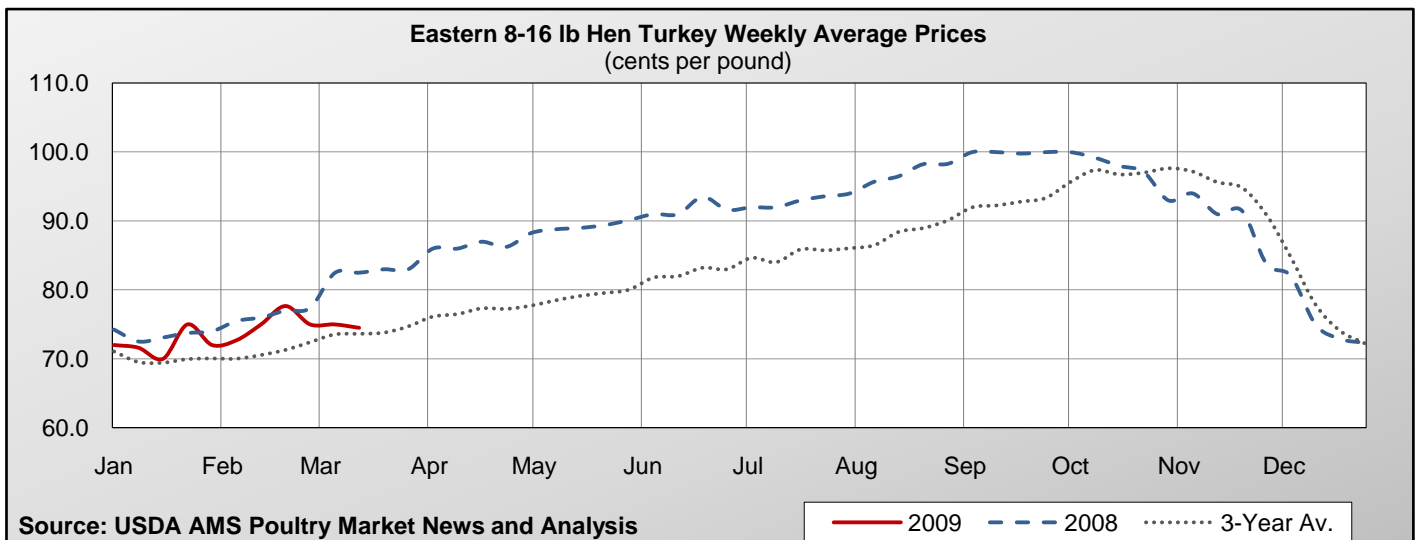
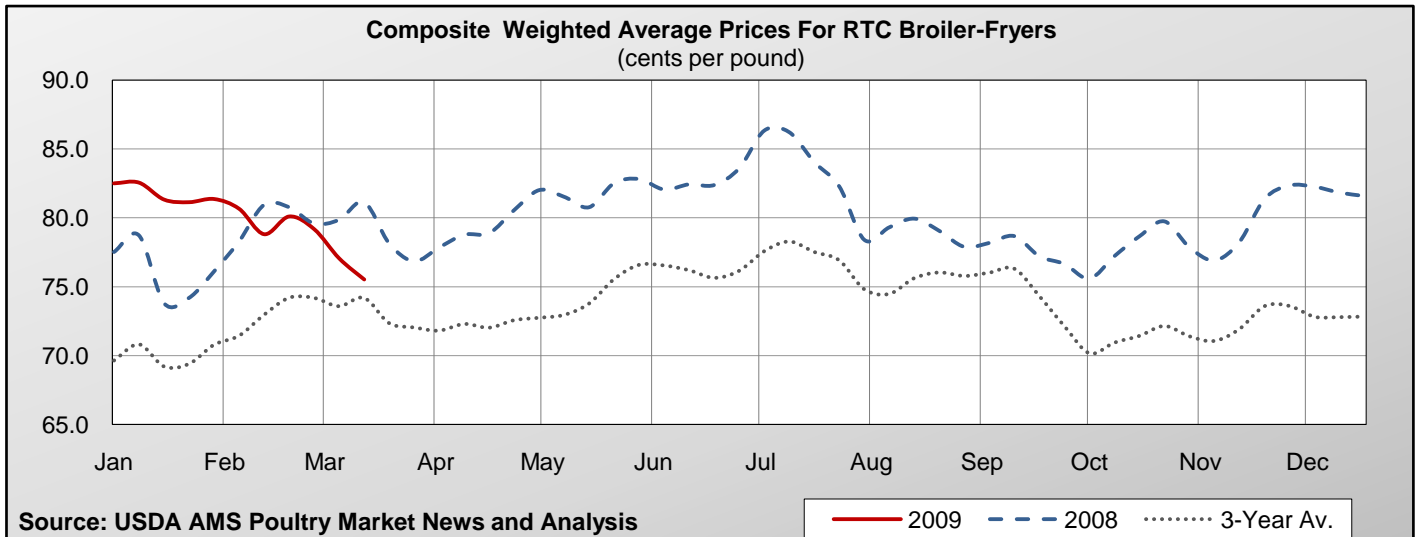
