MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER - Final majority prices moved lower into Chicago, unchanged into St. Louis and Detroit; Ohio cities TFEWR. Whole broiler/fryer market tone was mostly steady. Offers of whole birds were adequate on light to moderate trade call. Retail and food service movement was slow to moderate overall with some improvement expected late week for first of month. Floor stocks were sufficient for trade needs; weights desirable. Supplies of boneless/skinless breast was adequate, wings increased in availability, dark meat cuts were in close balance. Trade sentiment was steady to fully steady on breast cuts and leg items, and barely steady to weak on wings.
