DOMESTIC MARKET HIGHLIGHTS



The market tone on 8-16 lb. hens and 16-24 lb. toms was steady. No trading was reported. Demand was light to moderate with most interest for deferred deliveries. Offerings were moderate. The market tone on tom bulk parts was steady to firm. Trading was slow, due to short to barely adequate offerings and many industry members are attending a major poultry convention. Demand was moderate to good. Thigh meat market tone was steady to barely steady. Demand was limited. Offerings were fully adequate.

Offerings short to instances fully adequate with tails the most available. Trading slow due in part to some attending a major poultry convention. For domestic: tails 30-33 cents delivered.
