



NATIONAL EGG REVIEW



At the beginning of the week, regional prices were lower on larger sized and mixed on mediums. Throughout the week, all prices remained unchanged. Trade sentiment was mostly steady. Cartoned egg demand was light to moderate. Food service movement was light to moderate. Supplies were adequate to fully adequate for present trade requirements. Throughout the week breaking stock offerings remained unchanged. Offerings were adequate for the quiet demand. Processing schedules were full-time. Trade sentiment was steady. North Central regional light type hen removal costs were unchanged. Offerings were sufficient to plentiful for the light to mostly moderate demand. Processing schedules were normal to over-time. Trade sentiment was steady.

PRICES TO RETAILERS, SALES TO VOLUME BUYERS, USDA GRADE A AND GRADE A, WHITE EGGS IN CARTONS, PRICES DELIVERED TO WAREHOUSE, CENTS PER DOZEN.

MIDWEST REGIONAL Prices were unchanged. Trade sentiment was mostly steady. Cartoned egg demand was light to moderate, best into planned feature activity for next week. Loose egg movement was mostly light. Supplies were adequate to fully adequate for current needs. Central states breaking stock prices were unchanged. Offerings were adequate to available for the light demand. Floor stocks balanced to adequate. Schedules were full-time. Trade sentiment steady.

NORTHEAST REGIONAL Prices were unchanged. Trade sentiment was mostly steady. Retail demand light to moderate. Feature activity was very limited. Spent hens were at least adequate for normal processing schedules.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 01-Aug-09 is estimated at 157.1 million head. This compares to 157.0 million head the previous week and to 168.8 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 168.7 million head and the composite weighted average price was 82.28 cents per pound.

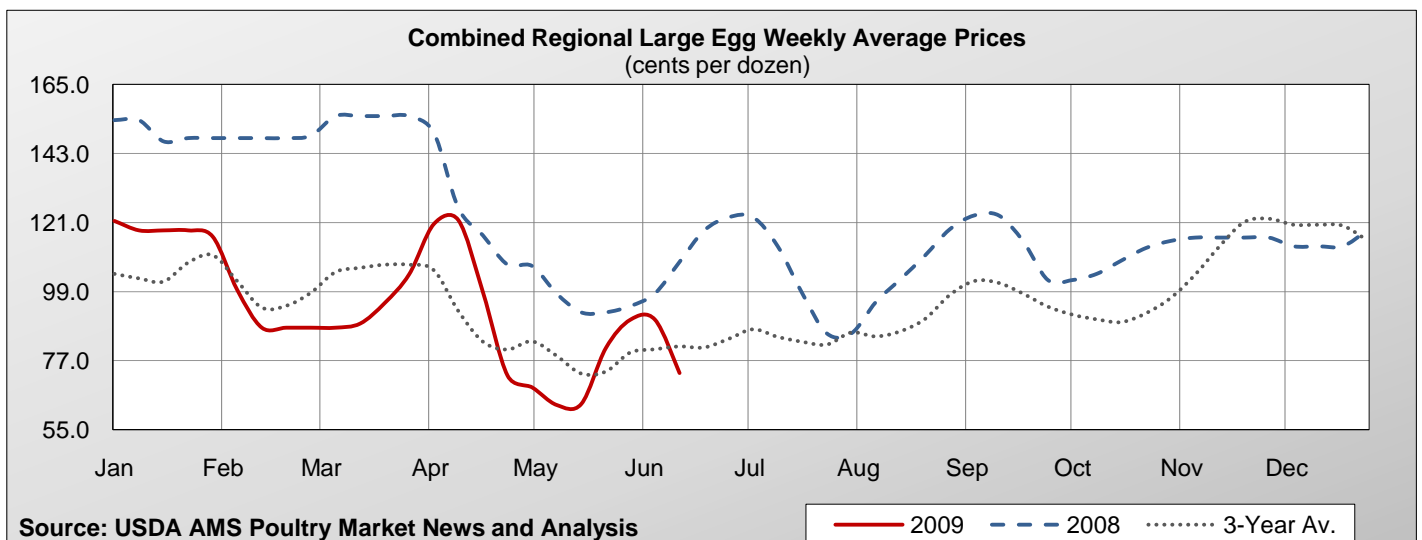
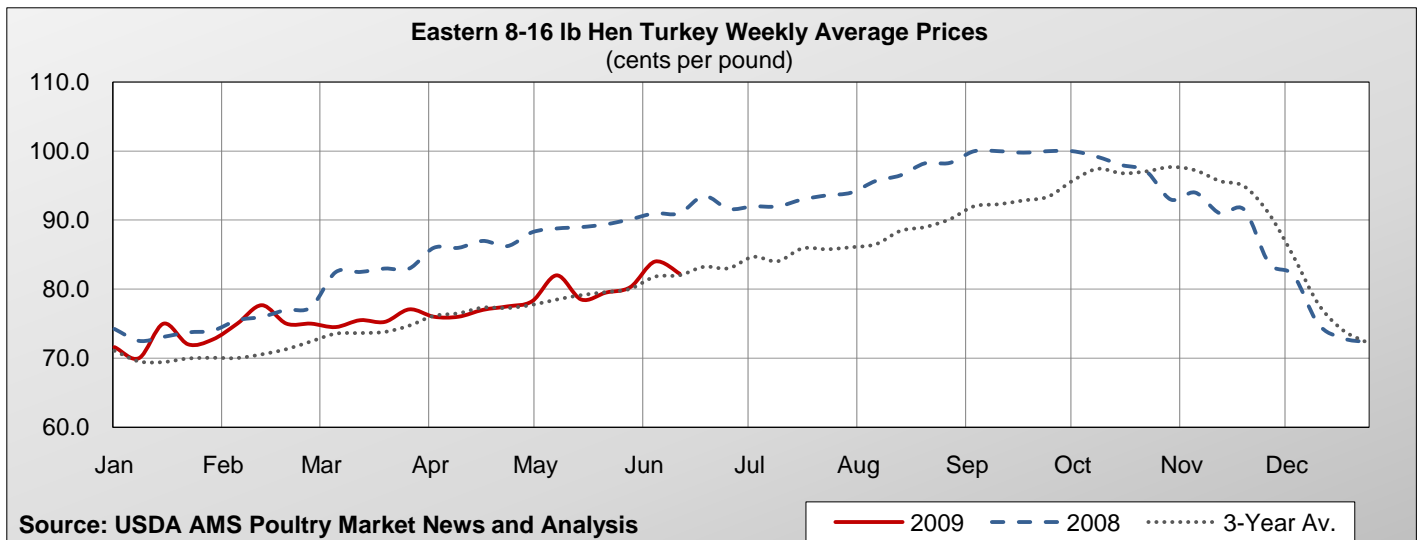
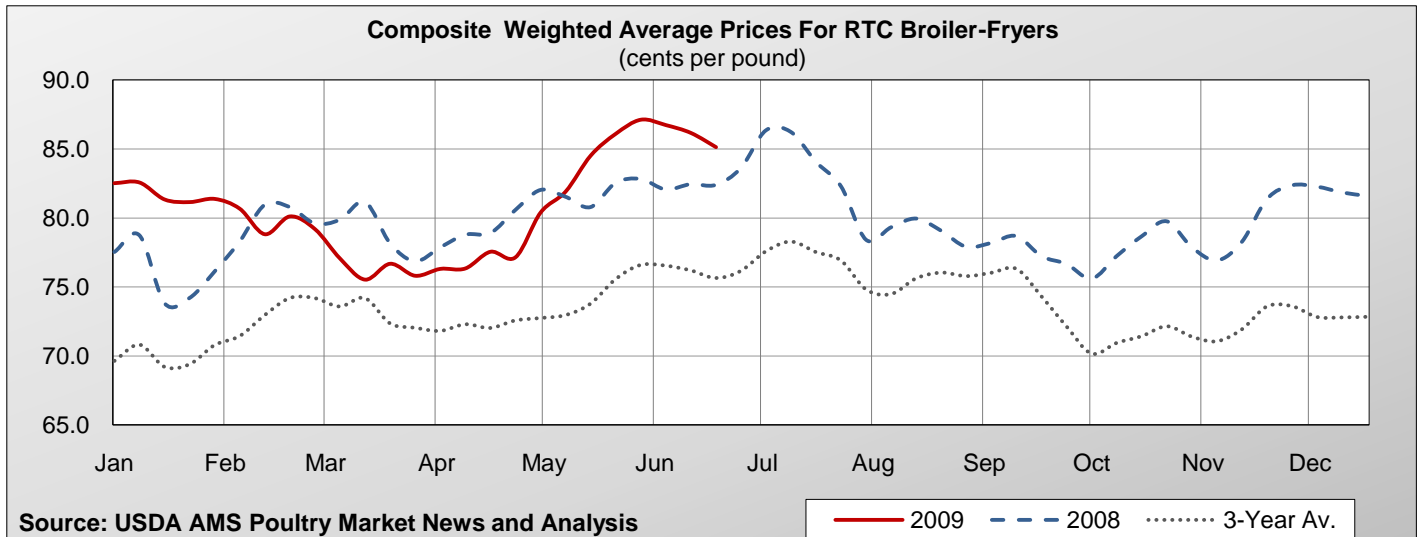
