

Majority prices were unchanged in all areas when compared to last week. The market tone was about steady to steady in the East, steady elsewhere. Retail and food service demand was light to very good. Supplies ranged moderate to heavy to satisfy trade needs. Floor stocks were adequate to long. In the parts structure, movement was light to moderate for early week business. Wings were light and moving satisfactorily. Supplies of breast and dark meat items were moderate to heavy. In production areas live supplies were moderate at mixed, but mostly desirable weights.

NORTHEAST Trucklot buying activity on ready-to-cook whole broiler/fryers was slow as dealers cautiously assess market conditions following the extended holiday weekend. Offerings of all sizes were moderate to heavy for current needs. Movement through retail and distributive channels was moderate. The market tone was steady at best. In the parts complex, supplies of breast items and tenders were heavy; wings were light and clearing satisfactorily. Dark meat items were mostly moderate.

SOUTHERN The market tone was steady. Retail and food service demand was light to moderate following the extended holiday weekend. Supplies of all sizes were fully sufficient to satisfy current trade needs. In the parts structure, movement was light for early week trading. Wings were light and moving well. Breast items were moderate to heavy, and dark meat items were moderate. In production areas, live supplies were moderate at desirable weights.

WESTERN Final majorities were unchanged from last Monday's final prices. Offers of whole birds and WOGs were adequate to fully adequate. The market tone on whole broiler/fryers and WOGs was mostly steady. Retail demand moderate to good, food service moderate. Floor stocks adequate. Weights desirable. The Los Angeles negotiated WOG weighted average was up .29 cents from last week to 66.14 cents with a volume of 35 loads. Trading was noted on boneless skinless breasts at 115-127, bone-in breasts 75-105, wings 140-144, Legs 58-71, bulk leg quarters 42-51, drums 55-63, thighs 45-60, thigh meat 90-105 cents delivered.

MIDWEST The Chicago market area final majority prices were unchanged from last Monday's final majority price; TFEWR in Ohio cities, Detroit, and St. Louis. The market tone on whole broiler/fryers was steady. Offerings on light weight birds very limited; other weights available on limited trade inquiry. Retail and food service movement was light to very good. Good fill-in noted into retail, sports bars and catering. Floor stocks were short to fully adequate; weights desirable to heavy. Supplies of wings were tight; remainder of parts adequate to available. The market tone was fully steady to firm on wings and about steady on the balance of parts.

<u>DELMARVA</u> Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was light following the holiday weekend as dealers assessed current market conditions. Offerings were moderate to heavy. Live supplies were moderate; weights were mixed, but noted as desirable. Processing schedules ranged moderate to moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 73 to 85 cents. The market tone was about steady. In the parts complex, breast items and most dark meat cuts were moderate to heavy. Wings were light and clearing well.

NORTHEAST BROILER/FRYER PARTS Trucklot buying activity was noted as light and selective as dealers assess market conditions following the extended holiday weekend. Offerings of breast items and tenders were mostly heavy. Dark meat cuts were moderate to heavy. Wings were noted as light and clearing well. Retail and distributive movement was fair to moderate. 
NATIONAL MECHANICALLY SEPARATED CHICKEN

The market tone was steady to barely steady on all fat contents with an unsettled undertone. Supplies of fresh and frozen 15-20% were adequate to available with the balance sufficient for current requirements. Many continue to closely monitor the marketplace in light of the contract season. Raw material supplies were adequate to available. Export and domestic demand remained light to moderate at best with some anticipating improvements to Mexico. Schedules were seasonally normal for the Labor Day holiday. Frame values were generally steady ranging mostly 7-9 cents FOB.


