MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER - Final majority delivered prices into Chicago were up six cents; Ohio cities, Detroit, and St. Louis were TFEWR. The whole broiler/fryer market tone was mixed, barely steady to fully steady. Whole bird offers were light to adequate on nonaggressive trade interest. Retail and food service demand was lacking, light to moderate, although eight-piece cutup saw good clearance. Floor stocks were balanced to long; weights desirable. Supplies of all parts were adequate for the light trade draw. The trade sentiment was steady to barely steady on all parts.
