NATIONAL TURKEY MARKET-AT-A-GLANCE

DOMESTIC MARKET HIGHLIGHTS



The market tone on frozen hens and consumer sized toms was steady to fully steady. Demand light to fair, instances good for current and deferred shipments. Frozen offerings light to adequate. Frozen offering prices on a national basis ranged for hens 76.50-82 cents shipping point and toms ranged 76.50-82 cents shipping point for current deliveries. Trading light on frozen basted equivalent consumer sized toms at 76.50-82 cents shipping point.

The market tone on white meat was steady to firm, tom drums steady to cautiously steady, tom full-cut wings mixed ranging from barely steady to fully steady, tom necks steady to instances weak, thigh meat and mechanically separated turkey steady to fully steady. Demand light to moderate, instances good with interest on some white items going unfilled. Offerings of white meat short to light, thigh meat spotty, and mechanically separated turkey light at best. Offerings of tom drums and full-cut wings mostly adequate, tom necks adequate to instances burdensome. Some over 6 month age institutional sized breasts are being offered at discounted levels.

EXPORT MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

Trading light. Trading was also noted on tom necks and whole tenderloins. Demand light to moderate. Offerings mixed with supplies varying by product and processor.

The market tone on tom necks was steady to instances weak with the balance of bulk parts steady to at times firm. Demand was mixed, light to good. Some reports of buyers being price sensitive and product selective. Offerings ranged light to adequate. The trade sentiment on white meat items was steady to instances firm. Demand was slow to moderate with best interest on white trims. Offerings were light to barely adequate. The market tone on thigh meat was steady to fully steady. Demand was limited and not well tested. Domestic and export trading remained slow. For domestic: fresh breast trim 140, fresh scapula meat 133 cents delivered. For export: frozen tenderloins 161, frozen tom necks 67.5 cents delivered port.

The market tone on tom bulk parts was mostly steady to fully steady, except tom necks steady to instances weak. Demand ranged slow to good. Offerings were light to adequate with tom V-type wings in the tightest position. The trade sentiment on white meat items was steady to at times firm. Demand was slow to moderate with continued interest on white trims. Offerings were tight to barely adequate. The market tone on thigh meat was steady to fully steady. Demand and offerings were light to moderate. Domestic and export trading was slow to moderate. For domestic: fresh scapula meat 128, fresh tom full-cut wings 69, frozen tails 37 cents delivered. For export: frozen tom breast meat 170, fresh thigh meat 118-120, fresh tom drums 68 cents delivered border.
