Mercosur and Argentina

Argentina is one of four South American members (e.g. Brazil, Paraguay, and Uruguay) comprising the trade organization Mercosur, which was formed in 1991. Last week Mercosur officials met with officials from the European Union (EU-27) in Madrid, Spain to discuss forming the world's largest trade block. The first round of talks are set to take place in early July 2010 despite failed negotiations in 2004 over issues with agricultural access for Mercosur to the EU and manufactured and service access for the EU into Mercosur. Presently, about 15 of the 27 EU member states are opposed to the negotiations and the formation of any possible trade union as it would likely mean a reduction in the EU's agricultural import tariffs and sizeable increases in imports of beef, pork, poultry, wheat, citrus, fruit, and juice from Mercosur countries


Poultry Programs Market News and Analysis Branch into the EU. Trade deals with Peru and Colombia and an association agreement with Central America were also supposed to be announced at the summit. According to Senasa, Argentine broiler meat exports increased 70.65% in the first 3 months of 2010 (43,755 metric tons) from a year ago (25,640 MT). Top export destinations of Argentine broiler meat were to Venezuela (13,329 MT), Chile (9,542 MT), South Africa (6,452 MT), UK (1,285 MT), and Saudi Arabia (1,175 MT). Most whole broiler exports are shipped to Venezuela, Chile, the Middle East, and Africa, whereas most broiler cuts are shipped to Chile, Russia, and the EU.



Leading Markets for Argentine Poultry Meat Exports by Volume (MT)




Mercosur Poultry Meat Exports to the EU (MT)

NATIONAL MECHANICALLY SEPARATED CHICKEN

(FOB Shipper Dock or equiv., negotiated prices in trucklot and less-than-trucklot volumes reported in thousand lb. quantities, cents/lb.; delivery within 2 weeks.)

The market tone was mostly steady on all fat contents. Supplies of fresh and frozen 15-20% were adequate with the remainder of fat contents sufficient to balanced. Raw material supplies were generally adequate. The marketplace was status quo as the entire protein complex was making last minute preparations for the fast approaching Memorial Day holiday next week. Some buyers were noting and anticipating seasonally good movement of finished products domestically for the present and upcoming holiday weekend. Export and domestic demand on frozen 15-20% was fair to instances good and light to moderate on fresh 15-20% with price resistance noted on both. MSC moved best into Central American channels with light and spotty interest into Mexico. Schedules were seasonally normal. Frame values were steady with trading levels ranging 8-11 cents FOB.

NATIONAL YOUNG TURKEY PARTS, INCLUDING BULK MEAT and FROZEN (UNLESS SPECIFIED), CENTS PER LB., DELIVERED FIRST RECEIVERS, PART AND FULL TRUCKLOTS AS OF 21 MAY, 2010.

The market tone on bulk parts mostly steady to fully steady, however necks were steady to barely steady. Demand was slow to moderate. Offerings ranged short to adequate with drums in the tightest position for current needs and mixed availability on tom necks. The trade sentiment on white meat was steady to firm. Demand was light to good with offerings short to tight and confidently held. The market tone on thigh meat and mechanically separated turkey remained mostly steady. Demand was slow to moderate. Grinds are more available this week in retail features with sausage most popular, followed by 93% lean. For domestic: frozen institutional *plant* grade breasts (basted) 20-24 lbs. 111, frozen institutional A grade breasts (non-basted) 8-10 lbs. 115, 12-16 lbs. 125, fresh wing meat 131, fresh scapula meat 145, fresh tom full-cut wings 70, fresh tom necks 58 cents delivered.
