<u>MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER</u> – Preliminary prices into Chicago were up 6 cents and TFEWR elsewhere. The whole broiler fryer price trend was fully steady to firm. Additional offers were light for the moderate interest. Floor stocks were light to moderate instances heavy. Weights were desirable to light as many producers were dealing with heat and humidity issues throughout the production areas. Retail movement was light to moderate. Food service was light to good, best into fast food, catering and deli's. The price trend was firm on breast cuts, steady to firm on wings, and steady to weak on dark meat lines. Supplies of breast cuts and wings light and dark meat items moderate to heavy.
