Domestic Market Highlights

The market on frozen 8-16 lb. hens and 16-24 lb. toms is steady to firm, mostly steady to fully steady. Demand light. Offerings very light to moderate with hens more available than toms. Frozen basted equivalent offering prices on a national basis for hens 100.00-108.00 cents shipping point and 16-24 lb. toms 100.00-111.00 cents shipping point for current shipments. Trading light on frozen basted equivalent 16-24 lb. toms 100.50 cents shipping point.

The market on fresh white meat is steady and frozen white meat steady to barely steady. Demand light to moderate. Some industry members are starting to find more activity on tom breast meat in response to the continuing summer heat wave in parts of the country. Offerings light to mostly moderate. The market on consumer and institutional sized breasts is steady.
