National Egg Review

This period, New York prices are higher for both heavier and lighter weight eggs. Early in the week, regional prices were higher for extra-large and large in the Southwestern region with the balance of reported regional prices unchanged. Next week's regional asking prices are trending higher. The undertone is fully steady to firm. Retail demand is moderate to good. Food service demand ranges light to fairly good, mostly moderate.

Offerings are light to moderate and held with increasing confidence. Supplies are light to moderate. Market activity is moderate to active. Central states breaking stock prices are steady with a steady undertone. Demand is light for the light offerings. Supplies are mostly

moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. National light type hen removal costs remain steady. Demand is light to moderate. Offerings are moderate to instances heavy. Processing schedules are full-time to over-time. Market activity is slow to moderate.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 07-Jan-12 is estimated at 142.3 million head. This compares to 139.9 million head the previous week and to 154.7 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 133.0 million head and the composite weighted average price was 77.07 cents per pound.
