NATIONAL BROILER Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady to weak. Offerings are mixed, mostly moderate, with heavier sizes in the East often heavy. Demand into all channels is light to moderate entering the weekend. Floor stocks are close balanced to short. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light to moderate. Prices are steady to firm for wings, weak to lower for boneless skinless breasts, and steady for all other parts. Supplies of boneless skinless breasts are moderate to heavy and at times discounted to help move. Wings are in good balance to light and the remaining items are sufficient. Market activity for parts is mostly moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are in a full range but mostly desirable.

The National Composite Weighted Average for 06/07/13 is 111.74 compared to 113.21 a week earlier, and 86.66 a year ago.
