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## NATIONAL BROILER

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady to weak in the East, steady in the West and Midwest. Offerings of all sizes are range light to instances heavy. Retail demand covers the full range but is mostly light to moderate entering the Fourth-of-July holiday week with improvement anticipated as the week progresses. Food service demand is light to moderate. Floor stocks are mixed. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light to moderate as dealers look to first-of-the month business and the holiday to stimulate additional interest. Prices are steady to firm for wings and tenders; steady to weak for all other parts. Offerings of wings are light to moderate and clearing satisfactorily; breasts are moderate to heavy and the balance of parts are sufficient. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

The National Composite Weighted Average for 07/01/13 is 105.10 compared to 107.07 a week earlier, and 80.48 a year ago.
