

NATIONAL EGG MARKET AT-A-GLANCE

Prices are 4 to 14 cents higher on Extra Large, 3.5 to 10 cents higher on Large, 1 to 2 cents higher on Medium and unchanged on Jumbo. New York prices are 2 cents higher on larger sizes, steady on Medium. The undertone is steady to higher. Current offerings and supplies are light to moderate for trade needs. Demand into retail and food service channels is moderate to good, however light to moderate in the Northeast region. Market activity is moderate while slow to moderate on the West Coast. Breaking stock supplies are moderate to instances heavy; demand is light. Spent hen offerings are fully sufficient for the light to moderate demand.
