USDA BUYS: ALL PURPOSE EGG MIX**DATE: September 7, 2007**

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) today purchased 180,000 pounds of all purpose egg mix in 6-ounce pouches for domestic food nutrition assistance programs. This purchase to be produced from about 13,000 cases of shell eggs from domestic production-was made at an approximate cost of \$586,000. Details of today's purchase follow:
