MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER - Final majority prices were unchanged; Ohio cities TFEWR. Whole broiler/fryer market tone mostly steady. Retail and food service movement was light to fairly good; best for active retail features, food service promotions and catering. Floor stocks were short to long; weights desirable to heavy. Parts trade was marginal as trade continues a cautious hand to mouth buying pattern. Parts supplies were in close balance on back one-half of bird, breast cuts and wings were adequate or available. The market tone was fully steady on dark meat lines, barely steady on wings and about steady on breast cuts.
