




U.S. Exports of Shell Eggs in Jan - Mar from 2005-2009 (thousands of dozens)


U.S. Exports of Liq/Froz Yolk in Jan - Mar from 2005-2009 (in metric tons)


U.S. Exports of Dried Whole Egg in Jan - Mar from 2005-2009 (in metric tons)


NATIONAL MECHANICALLY SEPARATED CHICKEN

(FOB Shipper Dock or equiv., negotiated prices in trucklot and less-than-trucklot volumes reported in thousand lb. quantities, cents/lb.; delivery within 2 weeks.)

The market tone for all fat contents was mostly steady. Supplies of fresh 15-20% were sufficient for current needs and clearing with the remainder of fat contents adequate to close. Many industry players continue to anticipate some supply changes with recent plant closings and ongoing production cutbacks. Supplies of raw materials were adequate to tight. Export demand was good, while domestically it was fair to moderate and spotty depending on end users varying production schedules; most interest centered on frozen. Exports continue to be most active into Mexico, the Caribbean, and Central American countries. Schedules were mixed, ranging seasonally normal in preparation for the Memorial Day holiday to short due to some equipment issues. Frame values were steady ranging between 9-13 cents FOB.



NATIONAL YOUNG TURKEY PARTS, INCLUDING BULK MEAT and FROZEN (UNLESS SPECIFIED), CENTS PER LB., DELIVERED FIRST RECEIVERS, PART AND FULL TRUCKLOTS AS OF 15 MAY 2009.

The market tone on bulk parts and fresh mechanically separated turkey was mixed, steady to firm. Demand was moderate to good, with most inquiry on MST, tom necks and wings. Offerings were adequate to short of needs. The trade sentiment on frozen white meat was steady, with fresh steady to at times fully steady. Demand was slow to moderate with offerings adequate. Thigh meat market tone was barely steady to weak. Demand was light to moderate. Offerings were adequate. Domestic trading was heaviest on tom necks for May-June delivery. Export trading centered on tom drums and thigh meat, other trading was reported as light to moderate. Domestic: Frozen non-basted A grade breasts 8-10 lbs. 115, 12-16 lbs. 125, fresh scapula meat 98 cents delivered. Export: Frozen tom breast meat 128 cents delivered.
