The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) today purchased 360,000 pounds of whole eggs - to be produced from about 9,000 cases of shell eggs - at a cost of approximately \$195,000 for school lunch and other domestic food nutrition assistance programs. Offers for bulk tankers were rejected due to price considerations. Details of today's purchase follow:
