The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) today purchased 1,344,240 pounds of whole eggs - to be produced from about 34,000 cases of shell eggs - at a cost of approximately \$788,000 for school lunch and other domestic food nutrition assistance programs. Details of today's purchase follow:
