**MIDWEST BROILER/FRYER** - Final majority delivered prices into Chicago market area were unchanged; Ohio cities, Detroit, and St. Louis were TFEWR. The whole broiler/fryer market tone was steady. Offerings of whole birds continued light on light to moderate buyer interest. Retail demand was slow to start for the first of the month, mostly light to moderate. Food service was light to good, best on eight piece cutup and wings. Floor stocks were in a full range; weights desirable to light. Supplies of all parts were available on light buyer call. The trade sentiment was barely steady to weak on large wings and dark meat and about steady on all other parts.
