WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 17-Jul-10 is estimated at 159.3 million head. This compares to 158.1 million head the previous week and to 158.4 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 161.9 million head and the composite weighted average price was 85.38 cents per pound.
