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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

As the week closes, New York prices are lower on all sizes. Early in the week, regional prices increased on both heavier and lighter weight eggs. All regional asking prices for next week are trending sharply lower. Retail demand is very light. Food service demand is light to moderate. Supplies are very heavy. Market activity is moderate to slow. Breaking stock prices are steady to sharply lower. Demand is light as most breakers await further market adjustments. Offerings are moderate to heavy. Supplies are light to moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. North Central regional light type hen removal costs are steady. Demand is moderate with offerings light to moderate. Processing schedules are mostly full-time. Market activity is moderate.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 09-Oct-10 is estimated at 157.4 million head. This compares to 158.0 million head the previous week and to 157.0 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 163.0 million head and the composite weighted average price was 70.38 cents per pound.
