released December 30, 2010

Shell eggs broken = 165 million dozen during November 2010, up 9% from November 2009, down 6% from last month.

November 2010 contained 22 weekdays (including 2 holidays) and four Saturdays, compared to 21 weekdays (including 2 holidays) and four Saturdays in November 2009.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) today purchased 336,120 pounds of whole eggs - to be produced from about 8,000 cases of shell eggs - at a cost of approximately \$202,000 for school lunch and other domestic food nutrition assistance programs.
